

Regulations of Ph.D. Qualifying Examination
Department of Mechanical Engineering
National Chung Cheng University

1. Ph.D. students have to pass the qualifying examination within the first three years (excluding the period of temporary leave of absence) since enrollment; otherwise, shall be asked to withdraw from the university. Ph.D. students who cannot pass the qualifying examination within the first three years due to particular reasons may apply for an extension of qualifying examination deadline up to one year with a certificate signed by the adviser and approved by academic committee.
2. Ph.D. students must choose three courses for the qualifying examination, including 2 from 10 core courses and 1 course designated by the student's advisor.
3. Ph.D. students must receive a point above 80 out of 100 or ranked top 50% in all three courses to pass the qualifying examination.
